In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licencing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

John Hollister of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, <sup>the</sup> owner of the whole of the Propeller or Vessel called the Princeton

is also presents Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Perryburgh in Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by her enrollment dated

at this port June 1<sup>st</sup> 1850 Numbered fifty three (53) now renamed having changed

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one Deck and three masts and that her length is One hundred and seventy seven feet Ten inches 177 ft 10 in her breadth Twenty four feet and six inches 24 ft 6 in her depth Ten feet and 10 inches 10 ft 10 in and that she measures four hundred fifty five tons seventy three hundred and thirty pounds and that she is a Propeller has no gallies and no head

And the said John Hollister having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
