In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Orville W. Ranney of Buffalo, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Schooner Amey Agar, of Buffalo, whereof Orville W. Ranney is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, New York in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port, Dec. 30, 1850, of Number Ninety One, non-surrendered, having changed owners,

And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One hundred and eleven feet and eight inches 111 ft. 8 in her breadth Twenty four feet 24 " her depth Nine feet and eight inches 9 " 8 and that she measures no hundred thirty seven tons fifty One ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner, and a Scull head

And the said Orville W. Ranney having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
