In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of the equal undivided Nineteen thousand, Twenty seven thousandths of the Propeller "General Taylor" of Buffalo; that John Webb, of Milwaukie, Wis. is the owner of Twenty seven thousand and fifty, Twenty seven thousandths of said vessel; that Thomas P. Williams, of Milwaukie, Wis. is the owner of Twenty seven thousand and fifty, Twenty seven thousandths of said vessel; and that John S. Kimberly, of Buffalo, N.Y. is the owner of the remaining Twenty five hundred, Twenty seven thousandths of said vessel; and all of said owners are Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller General Taylor of Buffalo whereof Asa C. Hart is

is also present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, New York in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment, No. 77 at this Port, 2nd Sept. 1850, Numbered 77, now amended having changed over as
