In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Oliver Bugbee, of Buffalo, N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Brig James M. "Bride" of Buffalo, whereof Francis G. Hooper is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving, Chaut. County, N.Y. in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port Sept. 29, 1849, & Numbered 87. Now surrendered, having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig - or Vessel has One Deck - and Two masts - and that her length is One hundred and Twenty-five feet and Seven inches - 125 ft. 11 in her breadth Twenty-five feet five and one half inches - 25 ft. 5 1/2 in her depth Nine feet Seven and one half inches - 9 ft. 7 1/2 in and that she measures Three hundred & Seventy one tons Eighty five - ninety-fifths that she is a Brig - has a Stern

And the said Oliver Bugbee head having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
