In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850—  
Wilson A. Fox, of Buffalo, N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of One equal undivided half of the Schooner *Star* of Buffalo, and that *Reuben M. Bruce*, of the same place is the owner of the remaining undivided half of said Vessel, and that both of said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>sole</sup> owners of the Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the *Star* of Buffalo, \_\_\_\_\_ whereof *Wilson A. Fox* \_\_\_\_\_ is the present Master; and as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Yarmington, New York* \_\_\_\_\_ in the year *1848* as appears by Enrollment, dated at the Port of *Oswego* 1<sup>st</sup> March, 1850. Numbered *A. No. 1* surrendered, having changed owners.

And the said *Wilson A. Fox* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
