In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850. — Robert Hart, of Black Rock, New York.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of 2/36 parts of the Propeller Pungussot; that John S. Kimberly, of Buffalo, is the owner of 3/36 parts of said Vessel; that Kimberly, New York Co. of said Buffalo, is the owner of 8/36 parts of said Vessel; that Asa E. Hart, of Black Rock, is the owner of 9/36 parts of said Vessel; that Robert Livingston, of Ohio City O. is the owner of 3/36 parts of said Vessel; that John M. Woolsey, of Cleveland, Ohio, is the owner of 3/36 parts of said Vessel; and that all of said owners are Citizens of the United States, and owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Pungussot. whereof Robert Hart.

is the present Master, and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City in the year 1847, as appears by her Enrollment, dated
