In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that, he together with Samuel S. Hallory, of the same place, constituting the firm of Stolley & Johnson, are each the owners of one equal undivided one half of the Schooner "Huron," of Buffalo, and that both of said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and ^{Said} owners of the Schooner "Huron" of Buffalo, whereof S. S. Parks is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan, Ohio, in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at Toledo April 5, 1849, N.Y.S. New Surrendered having changed Districts.

And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is one hundred and five feet 105 feet her breadth Twenty Three feet and four inches 23 " 4" her depth Eight feet and eleven inches 8 " 11" and that she measures Two hundred and Two tons thirty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has her name on her Stern and a Scroll head

And the said John S. Johnson having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
