In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850. —

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of one equal undivided one half of the Steam Boat "Minnesota" of Buffalo, that Rufus N. Palmer, of the same place is the owner of one equal undivided one half of said Vessel, and that said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the "Minnesota" of Buffalo, whereof S. W. Britt is the present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Maumee City Ohio in the year 1851 as appears by the Certificate of W. S. Jones,

Shipwright, dated 26th April 1851. and on file in this office.

And the Samuel G. Walker, Surveyor having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has one Deck and one Mast, and that her length is Two hundred and thirty five feet 235 feet her breadth Thirty feet and Ten inches 30 " 10 her depth Ten feet and eight inches 10 " 8 and that she measures Seven hundred forty nine tons forty five ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat

And the said George W. Holt having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
