In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for securing the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Robert Montgomery and Thomas W. Brundage of Buffalo, New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that they are each one equal undivided one half part of the Propeller District of Buffalo, and are

Citizen of the United States, and owners of the Propeller _____ Vessel called the Detroit of Buffalo _____ whereof Robert Montgomery _____ is at present Master, and as he hath sworn _____

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit Michigan _____ in the year 1845, as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port of April 1849, No. 10, now surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has _____ One Deck and Two masts and that her length is One hundred and Twenty eight feet and Six inches 128 ft. 6 in her breadth Twenty five _____ 25 " 0 " her depth Nine feet and Ten inches _____ 9 " 10 " and that she measures One hundred and Ninety three tons Seventy One _____ ninety-fifths, that she is a Propeller _____ has _____

And the said Robert Montgomery _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
