In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Lucius H. Pratt of Buffalo, New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he is the owner of one equal undivided three-fourth parts of the Brigastatic of Buffalo; that John H. West, of Buffalo, N.Y. is the owner of one equal undivided one-fourth part of said Vessel, that both of said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Brig astatic of Buffalo whereof Lucius H. Pratt is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port 12 Sept. 1850, N^o 79, now surrendered having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One hundred and Ninety feet 119 ft her breadth Twenty five feet and three inches 25 ft 3 in her depth Eight feet and nine inches 8 ft 9 in and that she measures One hundred forty one tons eighty two ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a Square Stow and a Scull head

And the said Lucius H. Pratt having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
