And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Mast _____ and two Masts _____ and that her length is Eighty two feet and Six inches _____ 83 ft. 6 in her breadth Nineteen feet and Eight inches _____ 19 " 8 " her depth Seven feet and Eleven inches _____ 7 " 11 " and that she measures One hundred and fifteen tons ninety three _____ ninety-three _____ that she is a Schooner _____ has a Square Stern _____ and Scural _____ head

And the said David N. Taylor _____ having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
