In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Watson A. Fox, of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that, together with Elijah W. Bruce, of the same place, comprising the firm of Fox & Bruce, are joint owners of the Brig "C. A. Bemis, of Buffalo," and that both of said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Brig "C. A. Bemis" or Vessel called the Caroline A. Bemis of Buffalo, whereof Watson A. Fox

is also presents Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York in the year 1849 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port, 29 Oct. 1849. Now amended, having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two masts and that her length is One hundred and seventy feet 107 feet her breadth Twenty three feet and one inch 23 " 1" her depth Nine feet and two inches 9 " 2" and that she measures two hundred and seven tons fifty five ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a Square Stem and a Scull head

And the said Watson A. Fox having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
