In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

is also present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio

in the year 1842 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port 13 February 1851, Number H. Now surrendered having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two masts and that her length is Ninety one feet and three inches 91. feet 3 in her breadth Twenty three feet and three inches 23. 3. her depth Eight feet, Nine and one half inches 8. 9 1/2 and that she measures One hundred and sixty five tons Seventy five that she is a Brig has

and a Seal And the said Watson A. Fox having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
