In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for receiving the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Lucius N Pratt of Buffalo New York owner Master  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>sole</sup> owner of the Brig Castalia of Buffalo or Vessel called the Castalia of Buffalo whereof Lucius N Pratt

is <sup>also</sup> presents Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky  
Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by her <sup>of Enrollment</sup> Record headed in this

office August 5, 1851, (last Enrollment took) by afft of L N Pratt filed in this office this day  
New papers issued having changed owners

And the said Record of Enrollment having certified that

the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and two Mast and that

her length is one hundred and nineteen feet 119 ft

her breadth Twenty five feet and three inches 25-11-3 in

her depth Eight feet and nine inches 8-11-9 "

and that she measures two hundred forty one tons eighty two ninety-fifths

that she is a Brig has a Square Stern

and a Small head

And the said Lucius N Pratt having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security

having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig

has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
