In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Carlton W. Millard, of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of One equal undivided three fourths parts of the Schooner *Sandis* owned of Buffalo that John H. Montgomery, of Buffalo, N.Y. is the owner of the remaining one equal undivided one fourth part of said Vessel, and are

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>Sole</sup> owner of the Schooner *Sandis* or Vessel called the *Sandis* whereof John H. Montgomery is also presents Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New Orleans in the year 1847 as appears by her last Enrollment, dated at this Port April 2, 1851. No. 11. Now surrendered having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that her length is One hundred and seven feet 107 feet her breadth Twenty four feet and three inches 24 " 3 in her depth Eight feet and four inches 8 " 4 in and that she measures One hundred and Ninety six tons Sixty three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a screw

And the said Carlton W. Millard having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
