In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July, 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he, with
Elijah M. Bruce, of the same place, as co-partners in trade, under the name & style
of Fox & Bruce, are the owners, as partners in common, of 17/24th undivided parts
of the Brig "Emerald of Buffalo"; that Edward C. Sherman, of the same
place, is the owner of the remaining undivided 7/24th parts of said
Vessel, and one

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig "Emerald of Buffalo" whereof James T. Osier
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Charleston
Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by her Enrollment dated
at this Port 2nd Sept. 1849. Now Surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Brig or Vessel has — One Deck and Two Masts and that
her length One hundred and one foot and six inches — 101 ft. 6 in
her breadth Twenty Two feet Two and one half inches — 22 ft. 2 1/2 in
her depth Eight feet and eight inches — 8 ft. 8 in
and that she measures One hundred and eighty five tons — eighty-fifths
that she is a Brig has a Stern

And the said Watson A. Fox having
agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security
having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig
has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
