In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Henry A. Hale, of Buffalo, New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of One equal one undivided one half part of the Schooner "J. P. Pratt" of Buffalo, that Sebastian T. Salcott, of Albany, N.Y. is the owner of One equal one undivided one half part of said Vessel, and are

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the "J. P. Pratt" of Buffalo, whereof Robert Mills is also presents Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1848 as appears by the last Enrollment.

And the said last Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One hundred and fifteen feet and one inch — 114 ft. 1 in her breadth Twenty one feet and one half inch — 21 " 1/2" her depth Eight feet and Nine inches — 8 " 9 in and that she measures One hundred Ninety Six tons Sixty — ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a small head

And the said Henry A. Hale having agreed to the description and dimensions above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
