Palmer is the present Master, and as he hath sworn as a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1852 as appears by the Certificate of W. B. Jones, of Buffalo, N.Y. Shipwright, and on file in this office

And the Samuel G. Walker having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck, and One Mast and that her length is One hundred and fifty feet 150 feet her breadth Twenty five feet 25 " her depth Eleven feet and one inch 11. 1 " and that she measures Three hundred & Ninety three tons & Seventy One ninety-fifths, that she is a Propeller has
