Addison Rice & Ernest Clapp, of New York City, comprising the firm of P. S. Stenberg & Co., are the owners, as tenants in common, of one equal undivided one half part of the Propeller "Mayflower of Buffalo"; that George N. Bryant and William Frost, of Buffalo, New York, are each owners of one equal one undivided one quarter part of said vessel, and are

Citizens of the United States, and owners of the Propeller Mayflower of Buffalo whereof George N. Bryant is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1852 as appears by the certificate of T. B. Jones of Buffalo, N.Y. Shipwright and now filed in this office

And the Samuel C. Walker, Surveyor, having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is one hundred and eighty five feet 185 feet her breadth twenty eight feet 28 " her depth two feet and seven inches 12 " 7 in. and that she measures six hundred and seventy seven ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has

And the said Pearl S. Stenberg having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
