In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Levi J. Mabe of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with George Washburn of the same place as partners in trade under the name and style of Mabe Washburn are the owners as tenants in common of the whole of the Brig "Virginia" of Buffalo and are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Brig "Virginia" of Buffalo whereof James Butler is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Erie Penna in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment dated

at the Port of Presque Isle, May 26th 1851 No. (3) This now sworn and having signed names & District And the said Enrollment

having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is Eighty three feet six inches (83 ft 6 in) her breadth Twenty four feet six inches (24 ft 6 in) her depth nine feet 9 ft and that she measures One Hundred thirty two ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has no galley and a screw head

And the said Levi J. Mabe having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
