In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Benjamin H. Buckingham, of New York City,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he, with Abraham Buckingham, Philo Buckingham & James McCulloch, all of New York City, as partners in Trade, under the Name and Style of Buckingham, & McCulloch, are owners, or tenants in Common of the whole of the Brig "Mahoning of Buffalo" of N.Y. and are

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Brig "Mahoning of Buffalo" whereof C. W. Piersons is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio, in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at Cleveland, Ohio 13 April 1847 No. 15. now renewed and having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is One hundred and Ninety feet and one half inch — 119 ft. 6 1/2 her breadth Twenty five feet five and a quarter inches — 24 ft. 5 1/4 her depth Nine feet and eight inches — 9 ft. 8 in. and that she measures Two hundred fifty nine tons — ninety-fifths, that she is a Brig has a Square Stern and square head

And the said Benjamin H. Buckingham having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
