In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

~~Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Steam Boat~~ or Vessel called the Great Western of Buffalo whereof W. N. Bloomfield of Buffalo is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built and ~~run on~~ Ohio in the year 1838 as appears by her Enrollment dated

at this Port 23rd May 1851 N^o 45, now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast and that her length is One hundred and Eighty Six feet 186 ft her breadth Thirty four feet and four inches 34.4 in her depth Thirteen feet 13" and that she measures Seven hundred Eighty tons seventy-fifths that she is a Steam Boat has a figure head

And the said Robert N. Stevens having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
