In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Oliver Bugbee of Buffalo New York having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Stranger of Buffalo whereof Oliver Bugbee of Buffalo  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan  
Ohio in the year 1843 as appears by Her Enrollment dated  
at Detroit 26<sup>th</sup> Aug 1851 No 42. Now summed and having changed District & owners  
And the said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that  
her length is Eighty Six feet 86 ft  
her breadth Twenty feet and two inches 20 " 2 in  
her depth Seven feet and Eleven inches 7 " 11 "  
and that she measures one hundred & twenty seven Ninety two ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has no Gallies  
and a Sloop head

And the said Oliver Bugbee having  
agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security  
having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner  
has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
