In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Weber Squire of Dunkirk New York
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together
 with Hanson A. Wisley of the same place are each the owners
 of one equal undivided half part of the Propeller "California"
 of Buffalo, and that they are

Citizens of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the
 California whereof James Connelly

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
 is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo
 New York in the year 1840 as appears by her Enrollment dated
 at this Port 21st day of May 1844 No. 57. No Surrendered having changed owner

And ^{said} the Enrollment having certified that
 the said Propeller or Vessel has one Deck and one Mast and that
 her length is one hundred & sixty nine feet & five inches 169 ft 5 in
 her breadth Twenty five feet and five inches 25 " 5 "
 her depth Ten feet and three inches 10 " 3 "
 and that she measures four hundred & twenty six ^{square} feet
 that she is a Propeller has no galleries

And the said Weber Squire ^{and} head
 having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security
 having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller
 has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
