In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licencing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for guarding the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Lucius A. Pratt, John Hallister and Squire Alexander, of Buffalo, New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that Lucius A. Pratt, of the City of Buffalo, owns one undivided one half part of the Propeller "Buccephalus of Buffalo"; that John Hallister, of the same place owns one undivided 3/8 part of said Vessel, and that Squire Alexander, of the same place, owns one undivided 1/8 part of said Vessel, and that all of said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and owners of the Propeller or Vessel called the "Buccephalus of Buffalo" whereof Squire Alexander is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Samburg in the State of Ohio, in the year 1852 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at Toledo, May 3, 1852, do hereby certify and show changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has Two decks and One mast, and that her length is One hundred and sixty nine feet 16 1/2 feet her breadth Twenty eight feet 28 " her depth Eleven feet (taking half her width) 11 " and that she measures four hundred and ninety two ninety-five tons that she is a Propeller has her Wheel at the Stem

And the said L. A. Pratt, John Hallister and Squire Alexander, having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
