In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Jason Parker of Buffalo N.Y.
Having taken and subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of one undivided 1/4 part of the Schooner Florence of Buffalo and that Alex. Rogers S. McBlen of Milan Ohio partners in trade, are the owners of 3/8 parts of said vessel and that John Stevens of Milan Ohio is the owner of 3/8 parts of said vessel and that all of said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Florence whereof John S. Gooley of Milan Ohio

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port April 8. 1850. No. 22 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two masts and that her length is Eighty Seven feet & Seven inches 87ft 7in her breadth Nineteen feet and nine inches 19 " 9 " her depth Seven feet and Seven inches 7 " 7 " and that she measures one hundred Ninety tons forty ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Steel

And the said Jason Parker and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
