In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Henry P. Darow of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Ogenius Bristol of the same place partners in trade under the name and style of Darow & Bristol are

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Henry S. Lansing of Buffalo whereof Edward Curtis is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1852 as appears by the Certificate of Vincent Bidwell Shipwright on file in this office

And Lucian Hawley Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred and forty one feet and seven inches 141 ft 7 in her breadth Twenty six feet and nine inches 26 ft 9 in her depth Ten feet five and one half inches 10 5 1/2 and that she measures three hundred sixty nine tons sixty four and one fifth that she is a Schooner has square stem and no figure

And the said Henry P. Darow having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
