Priestat of the same place Comprising the firm, and under the name and style of N.P. Darrow & Co are ~~each~~ ^{Equal} the owners of one undivided one half Part of the Brig Northampton and are

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owners of the Brig Northampton or Vessel called the Northampton whereof John Riley is the present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment dated at Sandusky 21st April 1849. No 10. now surrendered having changed owners & Districts

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Crew and two Masts and that her length is One hundred & nineteen feet 119 ft her breadth Twenty five feet and three inches 25 " 3 in her depth Eight feet and nine inches 8 " 9 " and that she measures Two hundred & forty one tons Eighty two ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig having been altered in her rig

And a scroll And the said Nearry P. Darrow having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
