In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licencing Ships and Vessels," Pa. passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Cyprianus C. Bristol of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of one equal undivided one half part of the Schooner "George & Davis" of Buffalo and that the Estate of the late Henry P. Darrow of the same place is the owner of the other remaining one equal undivided one half part of said Vessel

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>sole</sup> owner of the Schooner <sup>or Vessel</sup> called the George Davis whereof Thomas D. Grover is the present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1846 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port 8th Jan'y. 1849 No. 1. now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is One hundred and eleven feet, three inches 111 ft 3 in her breadth Twenty three feet, nine inches 23 " 9 " her depth Nine feet, ten inches 9 " 10 " and that she measures Two hundred & thirty eight tons forty six and that she is a Schooner has

and a small head And the said Cyprianus C. Bristol having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
