And Lucian Hawley Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one Deck and that her length is Ninety three feet and Ten inches and that her breadth is Eighteen feet and two inches and that her depth is Eight feet and Seven inches and that she measured One hundred thirty six tons Twelve and that she is a Propeller has a Round Steam and No. 1 Gun head

And the said Edward R Blackwell having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
