In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 21, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the certificates of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Thomas J. Titus of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, ^{sole} and owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Wisconsin of Buffalo whereof Thomas Titus is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Conant Ohio in 1838 rebuilt at this Port in the year 1843 as appears by Her last Enrolment dated at this Port 23 April 1852 No. 49. now summended having changed owners.

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has two Masts and that her length is Two hundred Eighteen feet 4 inches 218ft 8 in her breadth Thirty feet 30 " 0. her depth fourteen feet 14 " 0. and that she measures Eight hundred Eighty Seven tons and fifteen hundred and fifteen pounds and that she is a Steam Boat has no galleries and a Screw ninety-fifths; head

And the said Thomas Titus having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficiently security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
