In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Jason Parker of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of the undivided 3/4 part of the Schooner *Whica* and that Erastus Scoville of the same place is the owner of the remaining 1/4 part of said vessel and that said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and ^{Sole} owners of the Schooner *Whica* of Buffalo whereof Austin A. Kirby is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan in the State of Ohio in the year 1824 as appears by her Enrolment dated at this Port 11th day of May 1850 7:32. Now Surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is One hundred and Seven feet and Eleven inches 10 ft 11 in her breadth Twenty three feet and Ten inches 23 " 10 " her depth Eight feet and Six inches 8 " 6 " and that she measures 199 tons 53 ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has

And the said Jason Parker and Scoville head having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
