In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for securing the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he is the owner of one Equal 1/4 part of the Schooner *Itica* and that Erastus Scoville of the same place is the owner of one Equal undivided 1/4 part of said Vessel, and that John Stevens and Austin Atkley of Milan Ohio are each the owners of one Equal undivided 1/4 part of said Vessel, and that all of said owners are.

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Schooner *Itica* or Vessel called the *Itica* of Buffalo whereof Austin Atkley is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan in the State of Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port 8th October 1852. No. 117. Now Surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is One hundred and Seven feet and Eleven inches 10 1/2 in her breadth Twenty three feet & Ten inches 23 10 in her depth Eight feet and Six inches 8 6 in and that she measures 199 tons 53 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has

And the said Jason Parter and Scull head having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
