In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

John Mitchell of Little Falls New York having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and ^{Sole} owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel called the Pemio of Little Falls whereof John Mitchell

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Albany N.Y. in the year 1852 as appears by the Certificate of E. W. Manderville Shipwright on file in this office

And Lucian Hawley Surveyor having certified that

the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one Deck and that her length is Seventy Eight feet and Six inches 48 ft 6 in her breadth Fourteen feet and three inches 14. 3 " her depth Five feet and Seven inches 5. 7 " and that she measures Fifty Seven tons Fifty five ninety-fifths; that she is a Canal Boat has a Square Stern and No figure head

And the said John Mitchell having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
