at Sandusky 14<sup>th</sup> Oct 1852. No 34. Now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck and one Mast and that her length is One hundred and thirty four feet 134 ft her breadth Twenty five feet 25 " her depth Eight feet 8 " and that she measures 250 tons & 50 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has and 710 head

And the said Olias Weed having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
