In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for regulating the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Silas M Allen of Buffalo N.Y
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he is the owner of the undivided 3/8 parts of the Brig Mahegan of Buffalo and that Harlow Millard of the same place is the owner of the remaining 1/8 part of said vessel and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owners of the Brig ^{or Vessel} called the Mahegan of Buffalo whereof John Waffle is its present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Monroe Michigan in the year 1844 as appears by her Enrollment dated

at this Port 3rd March 1851 No. 10. Now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred fifteen feet & ten inches 115ft 10 her breadth Twenty four feet Nine and one half inches 24ft 9 1/2 her depth Nine feet and five inches 9.5 and that she measures Three hundred forty eight tons & nine that she is a Brig has

And the said Silas M. Allen and head having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
