In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for regulating the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Elias Weed of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he with William W Weed of the same place Copartners in trade under the name and style of E. Weed & Co are

Citizens of the United States, and <sup>Sole</sup> owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Home whereof Elias Weed

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Lower Sandusky Ohio in the year 1843 as appears by Her Enrollment dated

at Sandusky Ohio 14<sup>th</sup> October 1852. No 39. Now Sun and having change owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that

the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is Eighty four feet & Eight inches 84 ft 8 in her breadth Twenty three feet and Eight inches 23 " 8 " her depth Seven feet and four inches 7 " 4 " and that she measures One hundred twenty seven tons fifty nine ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern and a Scull head

And the said Elias Weed having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
