In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

the said Schooner or Vessel has — One Deck — and Two masts and that
her length is One hundred and three feet and ten inches 103 ft. 10 in
her breadth Twenty five feet, seven and one half inches — 25 " 7 1/2 "
her depth Eight feet and Two inches — 8 " 2 "
and that she measures 194 — tons — 79 — ninety-fifths;
that she is a Schooner — has a Square Stern —
— and a fore — head
And the said James A. Raynor — having
agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security
having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner
has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
