In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

James A. Raynor of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he is the owner of one equal undivided half part of the Schooner J. M. Brown and that Mortimer Wilkie of the same place is the owner of the remaining one equal undivided half part of said vessel, and that they are

Citizens of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the J. M. Brown of Buffalo whereof James A. Raynor

is the present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cornwall Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port 10th Decr 1850 No. 134. Now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred feet, seven & one half inches 100ft 7/2" her breadth twenty five feet & eleven inches 25" 11" her depth seven feet & four & three fourths inches 7. 4 3/4" and that she measures 238 tons 55 windy-fifths; that she is a Schooner has a

And the said James A. Raynor having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
