In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

William O Brown of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of Three Eights (3/8) parts undivided of the Barque Canada, that Archibald D. Clark of the same place is the owner of Three Eights (3/8) parts undivided of said vessel and that John S. Bantam of the same place is the owner of the remaining Two Eights (2/8) undivided parts of said vessel and that all said owners are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Barque or Vessel called the Canada of Buffalo whereof John S. Bantam

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Chippewa City in the year 1847 & altered from a Steam Boat to a Bark of Detroit in the year 1852 as appears by her last Enrollment dated

at this Port August 4th 1852, now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or Vessel has One Deck and three Masts and that her length is One hundred & Ninety Six feet and ten inches—196ft 10in her breadth Twenty Nine feet & four inches—29" 4" her depth Twelve feet—12" 0" and that she measures Six hundred & Sixty three thirty eight ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a Square Stern and a Small head

And the said William O Brown having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
