In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, ^{and the Act of August 30, 1852} also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Wells D Walbridge of Buffalo N.Y. of the firm of George B Walbridge & Co having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that the said George B Walbridge & Co are

Citizen of the United States, and ^{Sole} owner of the Propeller Tray of Buffalo or Vessel called the Tray of Buffalo whereof J. B. Densham is also presents Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1849 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port 22 April 1852. 70° 48. now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one Deck and one Mast and that her length is one hundred and sixty three feet 163 ft her breadth Twenty one, one and one half inches 21 1/2 in her depth Ten feet and two inches 10 2 and that she measures 340 tons & 4 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round Stern

and head And the said Wells D. Walbridge having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficiently security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
