In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, <sup>at the act of Aug 30, 1852, amend for the same</sup> also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Watson A. Fox of Buffalo, New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Act, and having sworn that he with Elijah W. Bruce, of the same place, are each owners of One equal undivided each half part of the Brig "C. A. Bemis," and are

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>sole</sup> owner of the Brig or Vessel called the "C. A. Bemis" of Buffalo, whereof James Davis is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Saratoga, N.Y. in the year 1846, as appears by her last Enrollment, dated

at Sandusky, O. 14th Oct. 1852. No 35, her name having changed since

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck & two masts and that her length is One hundred and seven feet 107 ft her breadth Twenty three feet 23 " her depth Nine feet and one inch 9 " 1 " and that she measures 207 tons & 45 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a Square Stern and a scroll head

And the said Watson A. Fox having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo. N.Y.
