In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, ^{and the act of August 30, 1852 amending the same} also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for regarding the annoyances of Vessels used for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred and twenty three feet six inches — 123. ft 6 in her breadth Twenty four feet and ten inches — 24 . 10 in her depth Nine feet and six inches — 9. 6 " and that she measures Three hundred thirty nine tons sixty five — ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no gallies and no figure head

And the said Charles S. Mack having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
