In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, ^{the Act of July 30, 1850} also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

William S. Ferriss, of the City of Buffalo,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and ^{Sole} owner of the Propeller _____ or Vessel called the "Franklin of Buffalo" _____ whereof William S. Ferriss _____ is at present Master; and as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Albany, New York in the year 1851 as appears by her last Enrollment, dated at Albany 29 Dec. 1851, 1851, now surrendered having changed Districts.

And the said Enrollment, _____ having certified that the said Propeller, or Vessel has one deck _____ and no mast, and that her length is sixty one feet _____ 11 feet, her breadth fourteen feet 25/100 ft _____ 14. 25/100, her depth five feet _____ 5 ft 0 in and that she measures thirty nine tons thirty two, _____ ninety-fifths, that she is a Propeller, _____ has a round stem _____ and the _____ head

And the said William S. Ferriss _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
