In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Henry Wheeler, of Buffalo, New York
having taken & subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
"Etna of Buffalo" whereof Joshua Ellis
is at present Master, and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sheffield N.Y. in 1841

and rebuilt in the year 1843 as appears by her last Enrollment, dated
at this Port, Dec 9, 1851. No 89 Not surrendered having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts, and that
her length is Eighty four feet and seven inches 84. ft. 7 in
her breadth Nineteen feet and four inches 19. ft. 4 in
her depth Six feet and four inches 6. ft. 4 in
and that she measures Ninety four tons & Seventy One ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no galley

and head
And the said Henry Wheeler having
agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security
having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner
has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
