# ENROLLMENT.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, <sup>23rd Act of Aug. 30, 1853, amended in the same</sup> also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

George C. Washburn, of Buffalo, New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Brig Missouri of Buffalo or Vessel called the Missouri of Buffalo whereof James Butler is the present Master; and as he hath sworn by is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Union, Ohio in 1842, & built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1847, as appears by her last Enrollment, date at this Port, 26 April 1852, No 55, Not renewed having changed name

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is One hundred and four feet and seven inches 114 ft. 7 in her breadth Twenty feet, eight and one half inches 20 ft. 8 1/2 in her depth Seven feet, seven and one half inches 7 ft. 7 1/2 in and that she measures 153 tons 17 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a scale

And the said George C. Washburn having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
