Citizen of the United States, and owners of the Steamer Superior of Buffalo whereof William H. Forsyth is also present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Campden Ohio in the year 1845, as appears by New Enrollment, date at this Port, March 5, 1853, Vols 23, New Enrollment having changed owner?

And the said Enrollment? having certified that the said Steamer or Vessel has One Deck and one mast, and that her length is One hundred and Ninety One feet 191 feet, her breadth Twenty seven feet and seven inches 27 " 7 " her depth Seven feet and seven inches 11 " 7 " and that she measures 57 tons 17 ninety-fifths; that she is a Steam Boat has a high pressure engine

and no figure head And the said William H. Forsyth having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
