In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Asaph S. Bemis, of Buffalo, Ontario, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the S. K. Falk, of Buffalo, whereof Asaph S. Bemis

is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Superior

Wisconsin in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at the Port of Michilimackinac 25th June 1848, No. 30, then seven and thirty odd casks

And the said Enrollment, having certified that

the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is sixty eight feet and three inches 18 ft. 3 in

her breadth Sixteen feet and seven inches 16 " 7 "

her depth Seven feet and two inches 7 " 2 "

and that she measures 72 tons 92 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galley, a square stern

and no figure head

And the said Asaph S. Bemis having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
