In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, <sup>and the act of August 3d, 1852, upon the same</sup> and an Act, entitled "An Act, to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

John Falconer, of Baltimore, Maryland, by his Attorney, John H. Wood, of Buffalo, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that, he, with John H. Haskie, of New York, Co-partner in Trade, and \_\_\_\_\_

is at present Master, and as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Kalamazoo Michigan \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 1848, as appears by her last Enrollment, dated at Proque Isle, 3d July 1852, No. 9. Nor since said having changed owners
