In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1853, <sup>and an Act passed July 29, 1850, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes"</sup> passed July 29, 1850.

Oliver Bugbee, of Buffalo, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>sole</sup> owner of the Schooner Orion of Buffalo or Vessel called the Orion of Buffalo whereof John Glasgow is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Kuron, Ohio in the year 1853 as appears by the Certificate of W. A. Cherry Shipwright, on file in this office

And Samuel S. Walker Surveyor, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred and thirty seven feet and six inches 137 ft 6 in her breadth seven feet and eleven inches 25. 11 in her depth four feet and one inch 11. 1 in and that she measures 315 tons 35 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stem and uproll head

And the said Oliver Bugbee having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
